6. SLA 2024 and Hosting

Ronan was updated re hosting situation - the PPN hosted through SSP for the last 8 years each year a hosting SLA and MOU was signed. It was explained that the Secretariat had met with SSP in March to discuss the SLA, the minutes of this meeting were never agreed by SSP, despite revisions. The draft SLA was sent in early May and in August SSP advised the PPN that we needed to provide indemnities in relation to risks associated with employment, which the PPN cannot provide as we are not the legal employer, and we cannot ask our Secretariat to provide personal guarantees. We referred these developments to the DRCD and the council. DLR PPN are now in a situation where we must find a different host. The issues around finance were also discussed in general.

SSP has acknowledged the Secretariat's correspondence which stated that we cannot satisfy their request and that because of this the Secretariat have reached the conclusion that the PPN will have to look for a new host and requested SSP to continue to support us while doing so. We hope to complete this process by 2025. We want to consult the DRCD to see what steps we have to follow.

7. Finances 2024

Due to the delay in the SPC scheme, we cannot do the budgeted events such as training, meeting the councillors and reps network meetings. We will make a case to carry over to 2025. We are unsure as to total carry over to next year, as we have not yet received the Q3 accounts from SSP. The carry-over should include a contingency fund for the change of host. It was advised that the PPN needs to be cautious in spending for the rest of the year.
