- Between 2015 and January 2025, DLR PPN was hosted by Southside Partnership DLR.
 Department of Rural and Community Development have been proactive in supporting the PPN to find a new hosting organisation starting August 2024.
- Since February 2025, the PPN has been hosted by the dlr Chamber.
